Getting to the Venue:

- **Public Transportation – Metro (Recommended):** From Athens airport the easiest way to get to the **Municipal Theater of Piraeus** is **metro line 3 towards “Dimotiko Theatro” (blue line)** and disembark in the “Dimotiko Theatro” station which is the terminal station. It costs 10€ one-way and takes around 60 minutes. In general, the Athens metro is modern and convenient. Timetables [here](#).
- **Airport Taxis:** Get a taxi from the airport. Taxis are plentiful and can be hailed from outside Arrivals. Journeys to Piraeus take approximately 40-55 minutes and cost around €45-€50 (prices may vary depending on the time of arrival, at night the flat rate costs €70).
- **Rent a Car:** Another option is to rent a car, but parking might be difficult within Piraeus. Several car rental companies operate in Greece – it’s better to reserve a car online in advance of your arrival.

Where to Stay:

There are many hotels in Piraeus to select from, but you may choose other hotels either in the city of Piraeus or in Athens.

If accommodation is chosen in another district of Athens, it is advisable to book nearby a Metro station, in order to ease your transport to and from Piraeus and within the city.
